## How to submit your article?

You can submit your article by sending it to <u>contact@entreprenanteafrique.com</u>. We thank you to respect the instructions below:

#### Picture and bio

Please send us the name(s), picture(s) of the author(s) and a brief biographical note including the position and affiliated institution.

#### **Guidelines**:

- 1. Title : The title should be concise and avoid acronyms and jargon
- 2. Abstract / hook: A very short abstract/hook should be included in the beginning
- 3. **Length**: Maximum length should be 1700-1800 words including references, but excluding the title and the abstract.
- 4. Structure: Prefer an introduction, a main body with headlines, and a conclusion
- 5. **Style**: the article should be written in a clear, accessible and non-technical style. Please also keep the number of references to the strict minimum.
- 6. **Links**: The article should include links (HTML addresses must be indicated to the editors in a separate note and be valid).
- 7. Language: We accept articles in French and/or English.
- 8. **Tables and figures**: The article may include tables and figures with clear attribution and sources.
- 9. **Pictures**: Pictures are accepted with clear attribution (source and credits) and under the condition of being free of charge or copyright-free.
- 10. **Tables, graphs and pictures** should be sent in picture format (.jpg or .png) and their location indicated in the text.

# General conditions of deposit on www.entreprenanteafrique.com

- 1. The authors authorize the use of their articles for publication on the website <u>www.entreprenanteafrique.com</u>.
- 2. Texts and pictures are always presented with the name of the author(s).
- 3. The use of these writings and pictures may not give rise to any payment of copyright or compensation in any form.
- 4. The editorial teams of I&P, FERDI and the African Entrepreneurs Club have the right to refuse articles (without obligation to communicate the reason) in particular:
  - a. Writings against the law (racism, xenophobia, advocacy of violence or hatred, defamation, pornography, pedophilia, sexism, homophobia, *etc.*);
  - b. Writings contrary to the publishers' rules of conduct: bad spelling, sloppy form, unsigned or untitled text
  - c. Writings whose subject or form is of little interest to readers;
  - d. The representation of a work that may be subject to copyright;
  - e. Photographs of which the technical quality is insufficient.
- 5. Internet users who submit their article will receive an e-mail confirming acceptance and publication. Without return from the publishers after one month, the article can be considered as rejected.
- 6. Refused articles are not kept by I&P, FERDI and the African Entrepreneurs Club.

## A note on plagiarism:

If the paper contains extensive quotes or paraphrases, the author should clearly indicate the source. This also applies to pictures, tables and graphs. It is the responsibility of the author to ensure authorization to reproduce with his/her publisher.

I&P, FERDI and the African Club of Entrepreneurs take plagiarism seriously and recall that "any reproduction, representation or distribution, by any means whatsoever, of a work of the mind in violation of the author's rights, as defined and regulated by law" is an infringement offense under Article L335-3 of the French Intellectual Property Code.
